

INFORMATION ON SIGNIFICANT ASPECTS

MEINS CONSULTING, S.L.U. has implemented an integrated quality and environmental management system within the organization. Within the environmental management system, performance monitoring is carried out through a series of indicators, for which critical or reference values have been established to take action if these values are exceeded.

Additionally, the organization has implemented a procedure for the identification and evaluation of aspects arising from its activities. This year, applying the established methodology, the following significant aspects have been identified:

Significant environmental aspects:

- Hazardous waste generated by maintenance. This is considered an indirect aspect, which we control through environmental requirements.
- Diesel consumption of vehicles. Diesel consumption has been reduced from 6.82 L/100 km in 2024 to 6.62 L/100 km. A further reduction in total diesel consumption is expected due to the fleet replacement with new vans.
- Electricity consumption in Salamanca: it has increased to 332,73 kWh/h Ct. This increase is due to additional consumption resulting from extension of the facilities. Solar panels were installed in these facilities during the year.
- Electricity consumption in Coreses: this is due to the use of overhead cranes in the facility and increased production. Solar panels were also installed during the year.

In 2026, the vehicle fleet will continue to be updated with more electrical vehicles.

For 2026, the objective is to keep improving environmental performance by reducing electricity and fuel consumption.

In line with our commitment to environmental protection and preservation, additional improvement objectives will be scheduled to minimize the environmental impacts that may result from our activities.
